

DTS 2024 EVACUATION DRILLS

An unannounced evacuation drill for the Dallas campus was held on November 22, 2024, between 9:00am and 2:30pm. The fire alarms were sounded in one building at a time and occupants were required to evacuate the buildings and gather outside at muster points. The Campus Police cleared the buildings, and the alarm systems worked as designed with no problems.

Fire Drill Procedure for CBS & DTS-Houston.

Completed on Tuesday, November 5, 2024.

The fire drill test period was scheduled with Convergent Fire Systems for 7000 Regency Square Blvd for both drills.

Fire Drill time went from 10:02 am to 10:10 am on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. The following people conducted the fire drill, Terry Bryan, Freddy Toro with CBS, Shawn Sidwell with DTS, Trevor Huff with PGP Security and Albert Martinez with Boxer. We focused on the following items:

- Specific attention to walking the building and ensuring the strobes alarms were functioning in all classrooms, offices, and hallways.
- All aspects of the fire drill went well and orderly.
- This drill consisted mainly of CBS and DTS staff.
- This drill was unannounced beforehand for CBS staff and was not announced to DTS staff.
- No classes were in session at this time. Everyone (to the best of our knowledge) exited the building.

Fire Drill time went from 7:01 pm to 7:09 pm on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. The following people conducted the fire drill, Terry Bryan, Freddy Toro with CBS, Trevor Huff with PGP Security. We focused on the following items:

- Specific attention to ensuring people got out of the building and ensuring the strobes alarms were functioning in all classrooms, offices, and hallways.
- All aspects of the fire drill went well and orderly.
- This drill consisted of CBS and DTS staff, DTS students, and DTS faculty.
- This drill was unannounced beforehand for CBS staff and was not announced to DTS staff, faculty or students.

In summary, people were quick to respond in offices and classrooms. Everyone exited the building either by the front and back main doors and then to the respective sidewalk and parking lot areas. The strobes and sirens worked well in all rooms and there was no issue concerning the public being able to hear them as they are extremely loud. Fire drill maps are in all the CBS and DTS classrooms and offices.

ANNUAL EVACUATION DRILL

Dallas Theological Seminary, Washington DC Campus

October 4, 2024

The annual evacuation drill was held at 10:30am on Friday, October 4, 2024, on the Washington DC Campus, located at 9900 Old Keene Mill Rd, Burke, VA 22015. This is the location of Burke

Community Church. DTS staff and faculty were notified of the drill beforehand. However, students were not notified beforehand. Two classes of 8 students total were present, along with 3 staff members and 2 faculty members. Once the drill started through verbal announcement, everyone evacuated the building at the DTS exit and met at the designated muster point (fire hydrant in the parking lot) in 2 minutes 55 seconds. Staff members checked the restrooms to make sure no one was there. A total of 13 people, including staff, faculty, and students were accounted for at the muster point. People were quick to respond, and everyone remained calm.

Burke Community Church confirmed on October 3, 2024, that they have tested their alarm system on September 13, 2024, and everything is reported to be working properly. The sound, lights, and PA system are all functioning properly.

The annual evacuation drill of the DTS-Atlanta Campus occurred on Friday, December 6th, 2024, at 11:55am. This was an announced emergency evacuation drill by Jake Gross, Dean of DTS-Atlanta. Here are the results:

- Smoke detectors and fire suppression sprinkler systems were observed in the classroom space and throughout the facility.
 - Egress from the classroom space to building exterior took 44 seconds upon sounding the alarm. Egress was conducted walking at a normal, unhurried, pace.
 - A safe gathering spot for evacuees to gather outside the building was identified. The location is the parking lot, directly outside the egress door of the building.
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An announced evacuation drill for the Fort Worth campus was held on 12/19/2024 at 10:17am. There were six people in the building, and they all evacuated the building and met in the parking lot. Everything went as planned and there were no problems. Fire emergency procedures have also been written for the campus including exit locations, fire extinguisher locations, and evacuation routes. Christ Chapel Bible Church will determine whose responsibility it is to check the fire extinguishers.
